Stricter Loan Approvals

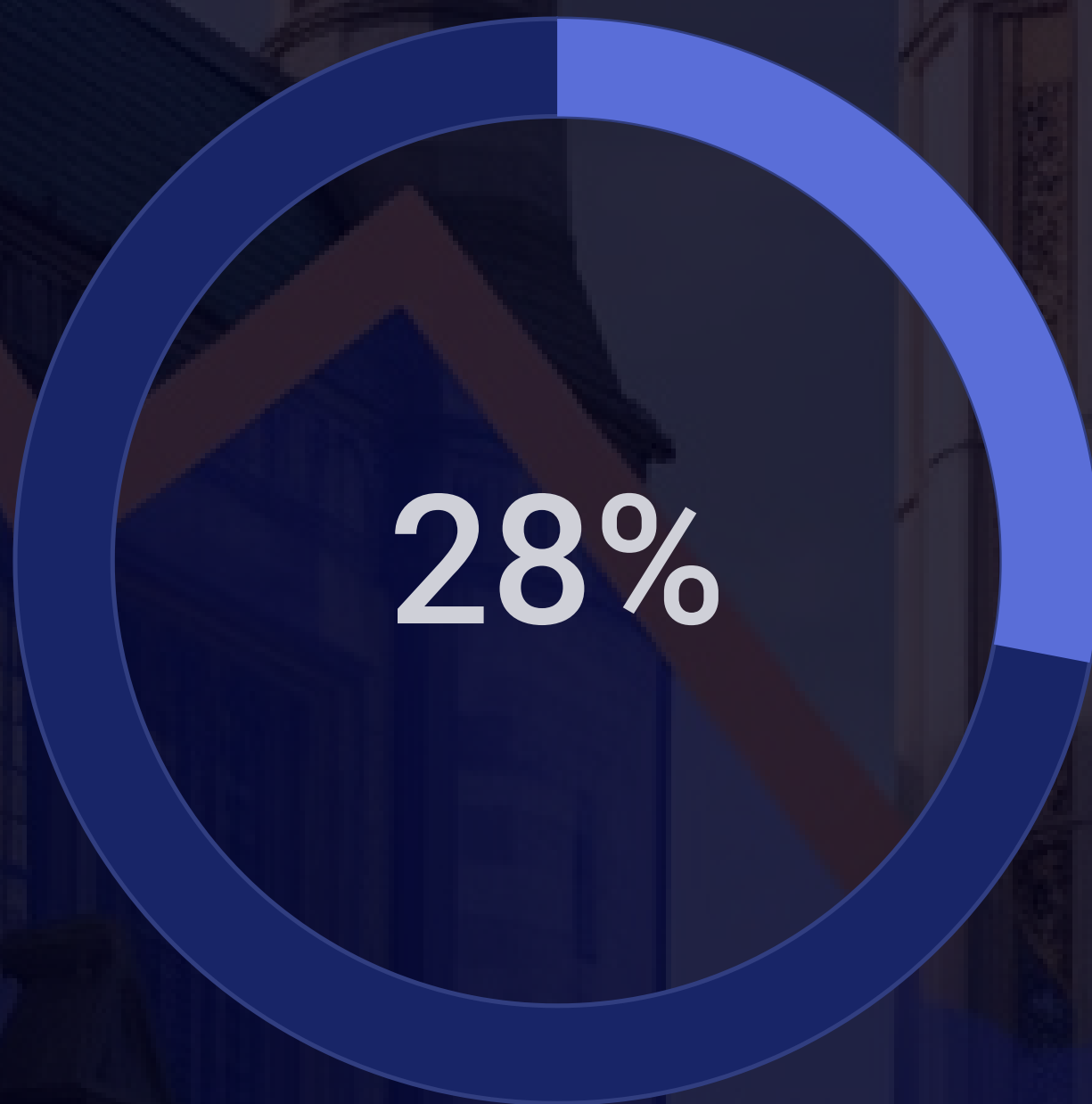
Lenders halved US loan applications, now prioritizing top-tier university admissions only.

Weekly work hours increased to 24.

Discontinued fast-track Student Direct Stream. Language tests now required for post-study work visas.

Australia Restrictions

Tougher financial requirements introduced. Stricter language proficiency standards. Plans to cap international enrollments for 2025.

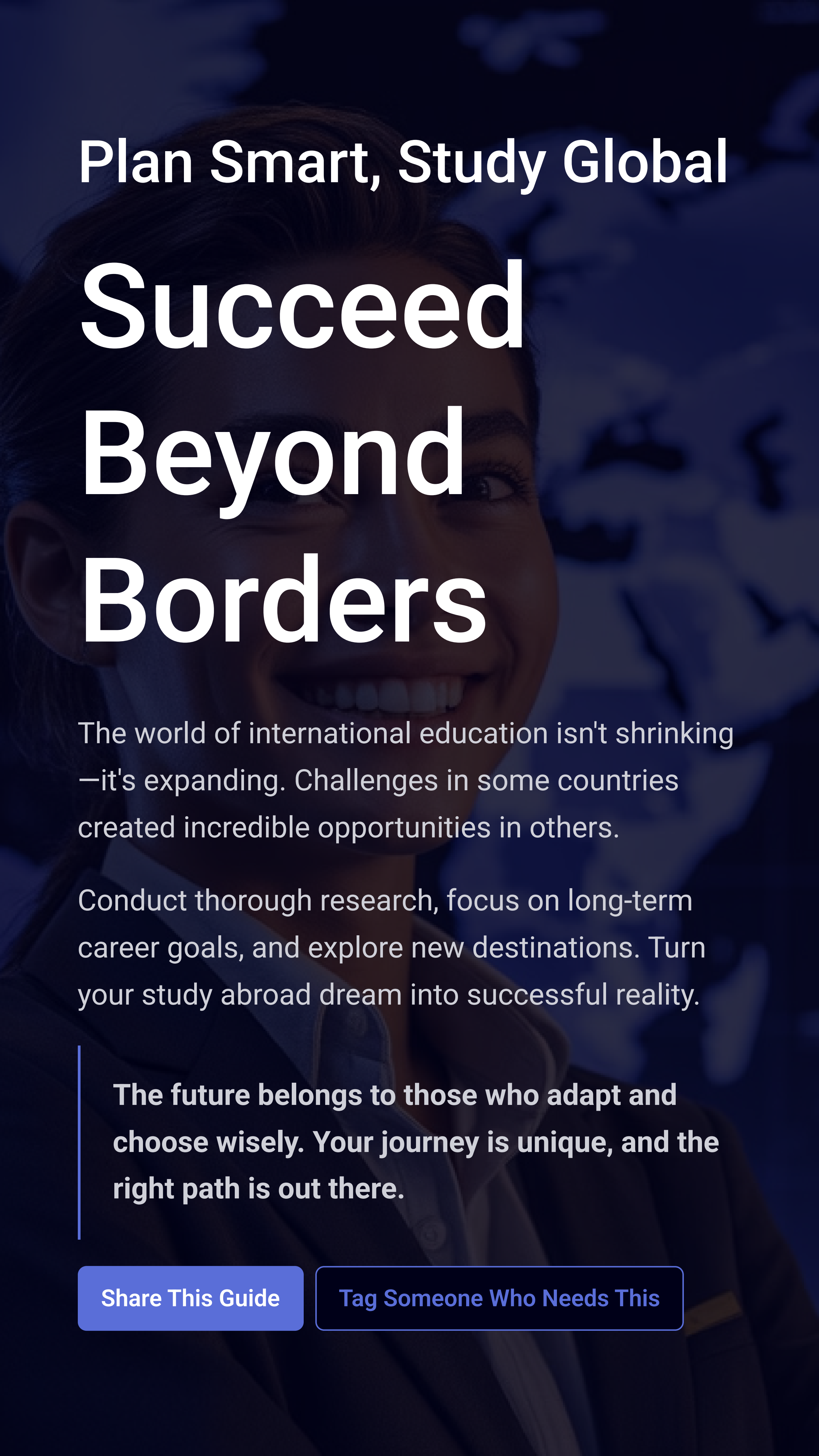
